

# Visit Jersey Safely

Jersey is open for visitors and as part of the UK Common Travel Area we are a **Green destination** and ready to welcome you.



NO need to have a PCR test **before** leaving UK



NO need to quarantine **when** returning to UK



**FREE PCR test** on arrival in Jersey

## Before Departure



### Register online

All visitors aged 11+ must register within 48 hours prior to arrival.

### » **Fastrack**

An option to send evidence of a negative PCR test\* within 72 hours of arriving to avoid testing on arrival.

**Fully vaccinated?** No isolation for **UK GREEN** and **AMBER** region arrivals.



### **GREEN**

- ✓ FREE PCR test on arrival and day 8 if still in Jersey
- ✓ No isolation if fully vaccinated (including children under the age of 11)
- ✓ Isolate until negative result of arrival test if not fully vaccinated (avg. time 12hrs), including young persons aged 11-17 years.
- ✓ **Fastrack** arrival by testing before you travel (see above)



### **AMBER**

- ✓ FREE PCR test on arrival and days 5 and 10, if still in Jersey
- ✓ No isolation if fully vaccinated (including children under the age of 11)
- ✓ Isolate until negative result of day 5 test if not fully vaccinated. Young persons aged 11-17 years are required to isolate until negative result of arrival test.
- ✓ **Fastrack** arrival by testing before you travel (see above) but you will still need to isolate until day 5 test result



### **RED**

- ✓ FREE PCR test on arrival and days 5 and 10, if still in Jersey
- ✓ Isolate until negative result of day 10 test whether vaccinated or not
- ✓ **Fastrack** arrival by testing before you travel (see above) but you will still need to isolate until day 10 test result

## Visit Safe



### Isolating

Isolate in your hotel room, or at a private residence.



### Public transport

Public transport can still be used to get to your accommodation. Remember to wear a face mask.
